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Pre-Operative Instructions For Patients Having Intravenous Sedation or General Anesthesia For Surgery

- Do not eat food or drink liquids (including water) for at least six (6) hours prior to your appointment.
Patients who take daily medication (such as blood pressure, heart or diabetes medicine, or antibiotics) should **take their medicines as scheduled (swallow with a minimal amount of water) unless told otherwise by the surgeon or their medical doctor.**
- Please bring the **name** and **dosage** of any medicine you are currently taking.
- Have a responsible person **accompany** you to drive you home. Minors must be accompanied by a parent.
- Do not drink any alcoholic beverages for 12 hours before your surgery.
- Wear short-sleeved, comfortable clothing.
- Contact lenses, nail polish, false eyelashes and heavy make-up should not be worn to your appointment.
- It is a good idea to have a few ice compresses made for when you arrive home.
- If there is any change in your health in the few days before surgery, such as **fever, chest cold, flu or persistent cough**, please notify this office immediately.
- If you have insurance, please bring forms with you.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO KEEP YOUR APPOINTMENT, PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED VISIT. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING YOUR SURGERY, DO NOT HESITATE TO CALL THE OFFICE.
